



Stories from the open road





Algeo traces the route the former First Couple took from their home in Missouri as they visited old friends in Washington D.C. then headed to New York to see their daughter, posing for photos whenever asked at the diners, gas stations, and hotels they stopped at along the way. 





Tall tales of long drives



