



ARTIST ALLEY RULES

Belmont Comic Con's Artist Alley will be curated and applications for a table will close on February 7th, 2019. We will not be able to accept any late applications. Both half and full tables are free to vendors, but we do ask that the artists take part in one of our panels or programs if possible, so preference may be given to artists who demonstrate a willingness to take part in the programming schedule.

General Rules

- All Vendors will obey federal, state and local laws and ordinances regarding the sale of materials.
- Sale of materials of a pornographic nature is prohibited, and any material suitable for adults only must be marked as such and out of the view/reach of minors. You may not sell adult material to minors (anyone under 18). As a rule of thumb: if it would not be available in a library, it would not be suitable for sale in the library.
- All artist's alley vendors must sell only their own original artwork and creations; sale or resale of mass produced merchandise is not allowed.
- Food & drink is permitted behind the table for personal consumption only, and cannot be given or sold to attendees.

Booth Displays

- Table displays and freestanding banners must be secured for the safety of all present. Free standing banners must be behind, not in front of, the table.
- Video/music playing at a booth is not allowed.
- Due to space limitations, no more than 2 chairs per table
- Items, either on the booth or underneath it, cannot extend into walkways or other vendors' space.
