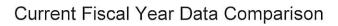

#### Directors Report – Thursday October 20<sup>th</sup> 2022 September Highlights

- Our screening and discussion of Suppressed & Sabotaged, a documentary investigating voter suppression, presented in collaboration with Belmont against Racism, had strong attendance and a very engaged audience. Post-film there were some great questions for our guest speakers Beth Huang of the Massachusetts Voter Table and Jacob Love from Lawyers for Civil Rights. Several patrons reached out directly after the event to let us know how informative and useful they found it.
- Craftalong for adults had a great turnout for the first in person meeting since Covid. Old books were upcycled and repurposed into works of art through a simple folding technique. Several participants asked for a repeat of the craft with a new design in the future.
- The monthly virtual Tai Chi offerings continue to have a devoted following. One patron in
  particular reached out to let us know that she's been dealing with a lot of stress while caring
  for an aging parent and Aisling's Tai Chi sessions have been immensely helpful and soothing.
- The Young Adult Librarian held Capstone Help one on one sessions to support seniors writing BHS Capstone Projects or AP Senior Theses, helping to bridge the divide between students and research while there is no high school librarian or databases.
- SAT Cram Spaces, led by YA librarian Hannah Lee, gave high school students an after school sanctuary as they prepare for the SATs
- Lots of collaborative library programming in the network with great attendance for award-winning authors Morgan Talty, Joshua Prager, and Daniel Nieh, and notable speakers such a Darius Coombs (Mashpee Wampanoag tribal citizen & Cultural Outreach Coordinator for the Mashpee Wampanoag Education Department) in honor of Indigenous People's Day
- The Children's Room staff signed up nearly 70 kids and their parents for new library cards
  for Library Card Sign up Month. That included visits to all four elementary schools for Back
  to School Night. Many thanks to staff who worked extra hours to help staff tables, answer
  questions, and sign up patrons for new cards.
- Our Outreach calendar is getting full again with the addition of Waverly Square Daycare as
  well as Payson Park Preschool. We enjoyed the chance to visit toddler and preschool classes
  with stories, songs, and puppets galore.
- We have added two more in person in library storytimes to our regular schedule, welcoming families with young children back to the library on Wednesday mornings.
- State Reporting to the MBLC is complete. A special thanks to Coordinator of Technology and Technical Services for leading these efforts. Great job Ellen.
- Belmont Library wins the Bronze Medal in the Library Card Signup Competition. Staff and Trustees deserve all the credit for this one.
