April Highlights

- Almost 2,500 attendees partook in the Solar Eclipse Party, largest attendance of any library program ever. A collaboration between the COA, Rec Dep. and the Library, the party included a food truck, games, music and over 500 pairs of glasses, generously purchased by the Friends of the Belmont Public Library.
- The Library was well-represented at the Age in Place Resource Fair! The fair, held at the Beech Street Center on April 30th from 4-7pm, brought many residents to the table to learn about all the library has to offer, even in temporary space, including databases, books, and the Library of Things!
- The Children's Room is fully staffed again! Our new Children's Librarian, Bridget Hoarty, started with us on April 1st. Bridget has most recently worked with the Natick Public Schools and has a lot of experience particularly with school aged children. She is already running storytimes and getting to know the patrons. We are really excited to have her as a part of our library community.
- The Children's Department had something for everybody during April vacation week. The Library and the Beech Street Center teamed up to create intergenerational events that all members of the family could enjoy together. Ed Popielarczyk brought laughter and amazement with his Comedy Magic Show. Local resident Arlene Smith created a wonderful tea party for kids and their dolls/stuffed animals/action figures complete with stories, snacks, and music. Families also got an incredible introduction to theater and music with Cat Tales, a collection of cat songs, poems, and story adaptations featuring actors and puppets. Between special events and storytimes, we had 273 people attend programs.
- Budding architects ages 2 and up got the chance to build with blocks of all kinds at our first
 of our new monthly Little Builders playgroup. Duplos and bristle blocks and much more
 were used to make all kinds of amazing structures while families had the chance to play
 together and get to know each other. The building toys were provided courtesy of the
